To All Interested Parties,

This letter is to notify you that an “Aquatic Vegetation Treatment Proposal” has been submitted to Dr. Earl Chilton of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, Austin Tx. This proposal is in accordance of the provisions of the “Aquatic Vegetation Management in Texas: a Guidance Document, and seeks permission to treat 38 surface acres of hydrilla on Lake Hawkins, located in Wood County (East Tx just north of Tyler). Lake Hawkins is roughly 750 acres in size and has about 200 acres of hydrilla as identified in a March 2, 2006 survey conducted by the Texas Parks and Wildlife.

The proposal seeks to treat 38 of the 200 acres of hydrilla by applying the herbicide “Nautique” in amounts consistent with the manufacturer’s recommendations. Nautique is used “for control of floating, emersed, and submersed vegetation in still or flowing aquatic sites such as potable water sources, lakes, rivers, reservoirs, and ponds...”. The expected date of treatment is to be April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2006.
