**AWARDS CEREMONY WILL BE AT THE WEIGH IN SITE**

**1. RULE CHANGES:** GREAT EFFORT, STUDY AND RESEARCH HAVE GONE INTO THE FORMULATION OF THESE RULES. IN THE EVENT OF A RULE VIOLATION, THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR MAY IMPOSE SUCH SANCTIONS, AS HE DEEMS APPROPRIATE, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION DISQUALIFICATION, FORFEITURE OF PRIZES, ENTRY FEES AND PROHIBITION FROM PARTICIPATION IN SUBSEQUENT TOURNAMENTS. THE DECISION OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR OR TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS SHALL BE FINAL.

**2. PARTICIPANTS AND ELIGIBILITY:** PARTICIPATION IN THIS TOURNAMENT IS OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THE TEXAS B.A.S.S. FEDERATION NATION AND B.A.S.S. MEMBERS WHO ARE 50 OR OLDER. ANGLERS WHOSE 50<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY FALLS IN 2009 ARE ELIGIBLE. PROOF OF AGE & B.A.S.S. MEMBERSHIP TO THE SATISFACTION OF TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COMPETITORS. TEAM MUST PAY A ONE (1) TIME \$40 MEMBERSHIP FEE. DURING THE OFFICIAL PRACTICE AND COMPETITION DAYS NO CONTESTANT MAY OPERATE A BOAT UNLESS PROOF OF BOAT LIABILITY INS. OF \$300,000 OR MORE WITH EFFECTIVE DATES DURING THE TOURNAMENT WEEK. **INSURANCE WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO BE SENT IN WITH THE TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION, BUT WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE ON THE BOAT AND READY FOR CHECK IF ASKED. IF THE INSURANCE BINDER IS NOT AVAILABLE WHEN/IF REQUESTED THE BOATER WOULD BE DISQUALIFIED.** NOTE: AT TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL DISCRETION, KNOWN JACKPOTTERS MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY THE ENTRY FOR THE CURRENT EVENT AND TWO OTHER ENTRIES PLUS ALL CHAMPIONSHIP AND MEMBERSHIP FEES

**3. PRE-TOURNAMENT PRACTICE AND OFF LIMITS:** THE PRACTICE FISHING HOURS AND OFF-LIMITS MAY VARY BY REGION. OBTAIN A COPY OF THE RULES FROM THE REGION YOU INTEND TO FISH OR CHECK WITH TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS. SATURDAY PRIOR TO THE EVENT FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 5:00 P.M. IS OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAY AND HOURS. OFF LIMITS WILL BE OBSERVED FROM SUNDAY MIDNIGHT THE WEEK PRIOR THROUGH 5:00 A.M. THE WEEKEND OF THE TOURNAMENT. DURING THE OFFICIAL PRACTICE, AND DURING THE TOURNAMENT, A COMPETITOR MAY NOT HAVE THE ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE OF ANYONE FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING OR CATCHING BASS OTHER THAN ANOTHER CONTESTANT; THE ONLY EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE IS THAT A SPOUSE OR CHILD MAY PRACTICE WITH THEIR SPOUSE OR PARENT. NO SKIN DIVING OR SCUBA DIVING ON THE TOURNAMENT WATERS DURING OFFICIAL PRACTICE OR TOURNAMENT DAYS. NO USE OF CB RADIOS, VHF MARINE BAND RADIO, CELLULAR PHONES FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING OR CATCHING FISH. ALL OF THE ABOVE MAY BE USED IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY FOR LOCATION PURPOSES ONLY. EACH CONTESTANT AGREES TO REPORT ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES IMMEDIATELY TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. FAILURE TO DO SO COULD RESULT IN YOUR DISQUALIFICATION. BY YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT YOU AGREE TO SUBMIT TO A POLYGRAPH TEST SHOULD YOU BE ACCUSED OF ANY RULE VIOLATION. THE ADMINISTRATION AND INTERPRETATION OF THE POLYGRAPH TEST SHALL BE SOLELY THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR SHALL SELECT THE PLACE, THE INDIVIDUAL, AND THE SCOPE OF QUESTIONS. THE CONTESTANT SHALL MAKE THEM AVAILABLE AT THEIR EXPENSE FOR THIS EXAMINATION. GUIDES MAY NOT BE HIRED 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT ON TOURNAMENT WATERS.

(A) **LAUNCHING AND TRAILERING:** TO HELP ALLEVIATE TRAFFIC AT HOST MARINA CONTESTANTS MAY LAUNCH THEIR BOAT AT 5:00 A.M. ON PRACTICE AND TOURNAMENT DAY, BUT MAY NOT BEGIN PRACTICE FISHING UNTIL 6:00 A.M. CONTESTANTS MAY LAUNCH FROM ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RAMP ON THE TOURNAMENT LAKE TO WHICH THEY HAVE LEGAL ACCESS. TRAILERING IS ALLOWED FOR ALL TEAM EVENTS. TRAILERING TO WEIGH-IN SITE IS PERMITTED IF YOUR LIVWELL SYSTEM IS ADEQUATE TO MAINTAIN THE FISH IN A HEALTHY CONDITION.

(B) **TOURNAMENT FISHING HOURS:** ON TOURNAMENT DAY YOU MAY START FISHING AT 6:30 A.M. (NO EXCEPTIONS). IT IS THE CONTESTANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK WITH TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS FOR START AND ENDING TIMES. ENDING TIME MAY VARY BECAUSE OF FLIGHTS.

**4. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE:** MAILED ENTRIES FEE IS \$150.00 PER TEAM WHICH INCLUDES BIG BASS. MAILED ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT DATE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR EARLY ENTRY. ON-LINE REGISTRATION CUT OFF IS (5) DAYS TO PRIOR TO TOURNAMENT DATE. ON-SITE REGISTRATION WILL BE OPEN FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M. SATURDAY PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT. ON SITE ENTRY FEE IS \$150.00. ONE (1) TEAM MEMBER **MUST** CHECK-IN THE TEAM AT REGISTRATION. FAILURE TO REGISTER DURING THE PRESCRIBED HOURS WILL RESULT IN A 1 POUND PENALTY FOR THE TEAM WEIGHT. NO EXCEPTIONS. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK THE AGENDA.

**5. SAFETY:** SAFE BOAT CONDUCT MUST BE OBSERVED AT ALL TIMES BY TOURNAMENT COMPETITORS. DURING THE OFFICIAL PRACTICE AND TOURNAMENT HOURS, EACH COMPETITOR IS REQUIRED TO WEAR A COAST GUARD APPROVED CHEST TYPE LIFE PRESERVER. THIS LIFE PRESERVER MUST BE WORN ANYTIME THE COMBUSTION ENGINE IS OPERATING. THE PRESERVER MUST BE STRAPPED, SNAPPED OR ZIPPERED SECURELY AND MAINTAINED IN THAT CONDITION UNTIL THE COMPETITOR REACHES HIS FISHING LOCATION AND THE COMBUSTION ENGINE IS SHUT OFF. TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS HAVE THE RIGHT TO DELAY OR CANCEL THE START OF AN OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT DAY BECAUSE OF BAD WEATHER OR OTHER FACTORS THAT WOULD ENDANGER THE SAFETY OF THE COMPETITORS.

**6. SPORTSMANSHIP:** CONTESTANTS ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW HIGH STANDARDS OF SPORTSMANSHIP, COURTESY, SAFETY AND CONSERVATION. ANY INFRACTION OF THESE FUNDAMENTAL SPORTING PRINCIPLES MAY BE DEEMED CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION. DURING OFFICIAL PRACTICE AND ALL TOURNAMENT HOURS NO COMPETITOR SHALL USE ALCOHOL OR DRUGS OTHER THAN THOSE PRESCRIBED BY A PHYSICIAN. THIS WILL BE AN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION. MAXIMUM COURTESY MUST BE PRACTICED AT ALL TIMES, ESPECIALLY IN THE VICINITY OF A NON-COMPETITOR'S BOAT.

**7. TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT:** DIP NETS ARE ALLOWED. DIP NETS CANNOT EXCEED 6 1/2 FEET IN OVERALL LENGTH. IF FISH ARE NETTED, COMPETITORS MUST NET THEIR OWN, NO EXCEPTIONS. B.A.S.S. RECOMMENDS THE USE OF A RUBBER OR VINYL-COATED NET. ONLY ARTIFICIAL LURES MAY BE USED. NO "LIVE BAIT" OR PREPARED BAIT WILL BE PERMITTED, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PORK STRIPS, RINDS, ETC. ONLY ONE CASTING, SPIN CASTING, OR SPINNING ROD (8FT. MAX. FROM BUTT OF HANDLE TO ROD TIP) AND REEL MAY BE USED AT ANY ON TIME. ALL OTHER TYPES PROHIBITED. OTHER RIGS AS SPECIFIED ABOVE MAY BE IN BOAT READY FOR USE. HOWEVER, ONLY ONE IS PERMITTED TO BE IN USE AT ANY GIVEN TIME. ALL BASS MUST BE CAUGHT LIVE AND IN A CONVENTIONAL SPORTING MANNER. ANYONE GUILTY OF SNATCHING OR SNAGGING VISIBLE FISH WILL HAVE THEIR DAY'S CATCH DISQUALIFIED. WHEN VISIBLE FISHING ALL BASS MUST BE HOOKED INSIDE THE MOUTH AND MUST BE VERIFIED BY YOUR PARTNER BEFORE UNHOOKING TO BE A LEGAL FISH. NO GAFFS MAY BE USED TO BOAT A BASS OR BE PERMITTED IN THE BOAT AT ANY TIME. THE USE OF GRIPPERS IN LANDING BASS IS PROHIBITED.

**8. HORSEPOWER REGULATIONS:** MAXIMUM OUTBOARD MOTOR HORSEPOWER FOR ALL COMPETITORS WILL BE 250HP. NO OUTBOARD MOTOR MAY EXCEED THE COAST GUARD MAXIMUM HORSEPOWER RATING FOR THE BOAT IT IS MOUNTED ON. NO ALTERED MOTORS TO INCREASE THE HORSEPOWER OVER THE FACTORY RATING ARE ALLOWED.

**9. BOAT AND MOTOR:** FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL, BOATS MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH SOME TYPE OF IGNITION KILL SWITCH. THIS DEVICE MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE DRIVER ANY TIME THE COMBUSTION ENGINE IS OPERATING. ALL BOATS MUST BE 15FT OR MORE IN LENGTH. NO RAISED PLATFORMS OR DECKS HIGHER THAN THE GUNNELS ARE ALLOWED. AN ELECTRIC TROLLING MOTOR MAY BE USED FOR POSITIONING ONLY. NO TROLLING FOR THE PURPOSES OF FISHING. NO BLADDER OR AUXILIARY GAS TANKS THAT WERE NOT INSTALLED BY THE BOAT MANUFACTURER ARE PERMITTED. NO STICK STEERING BOATS PERMITTED TO BE USED. EACH CONTESTANT BEING CONSIDERED A BOATER IS EXPECTED TO MAKE THAT BOAT AND MOTOR AVAILABLE FOR TOURNAMENT USE BY HIMSELF AND HIS DAILY PARTNER. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTNERS TO MUTUALLY AGREE ON SHARING THE OPERATIONAL EXPENSES. IF THEY CAN'T AGREE THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR SHALL MAKE SUCH DETERMINATIONS.

**10. BASIC BOAT EQUIPMENT:** EVERY BOAT MUST HAVE ALL REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT. IN ADDITION IT MUST HAVE A FUNCTIONAL BILGE PUMP AND LIVE WELL SPACE, PROPERLY AERATED, TO ADEQUATELY MAINTAIN A LIMIT OF FIVE (5) BASS.

**11. "THE TEAM":** ONE OF THE CONTESTANTS MAY, BY NECESSITY, FISH ALONE IF THE TEAM ENTRY FEE IS PAID. HOWEVER, TBFN RESERVES THE RIGHT TO APPOINT A NON-FISHING OBSERVER TO ACCOMPANY ANY SINGLE CONTESTANT. CHANGING PARTNERS OR ACQUIRING ANOTHER PARTNER IS ALLOWED DURING THE COURSE OF THE TOURNAMENT SEASON BUT POINTS EARNED BY THE "TEAM" PRIOR TO THE CHANGE OR ACQUISITION OF A NEW PARTNER WILL BE DISCARDED. A "TEAM" CAN CONSIST OF ONLY ONE INDIVIDUAL, BUT FULL ENTRY FEE AND BOTH INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP FEES MUST BE PAID.

**12. PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS:** THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR SHALL ESTABLISH TOURNAMENT WATERS. NO FISHING WITHIN 50 YARDS OF ANOTHER COMPETITOR'S BOAT WHICH WAS FIRST ANCHORED OR SECURED IN A FIXED POSITION WITH THE TROLLING MOTOR OUT OF THE WATER. ALL ANCHORED BOATS ARE REQUIRED TO ADVISE ANY OTHER COMPETITOR WHEN SUCH BOAT BELIEVES ANOTHER COMPETITOR IS CLOSE TO BEING WITHIN THIS 50-YARD CIRCLE. ANY AREA POSTED OFF LIMITS OR NO FISHING BY STATE OR FEDERAL OFFICIALS WILL BE OFF LIMITS. THE LIVE BASS RELEASE AREA ESTABLISHED BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL BE OFF LIMITS. THIS AREA WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE TOURNAMENT BRIEFING. ALL ANGLING MUST BE DONE FROM A TOURNAMENT BOAT.

**13. POLYGRAPH AND PROTESTS:** ALL CONTESTANTS PLACING IN A MONEY WINNING POSITION IN THE TOURNAMENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE SUBJECT TO TAKE ONE OR MORE POLYGRAPH TESTS. IF WRITTEN PROTESTS ARE FILED BY A CONTESTANT, BOTH PARTIES INVOLVED IN PROTEST ARE SUBJECT TO TAKE ONE OR MORE POLYGRAPH TEST. A WRITTEN PROTEST MUST BE OFFICIALLY SUBMITTED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES AFTER FINAL WEIGH-IN ON THE TOURNAMENT DAY OR BY THE END OF THE REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR PROTESTS CONCERNING PRACTICE DAY, AND THE TX NUMBERS OF ALLEGED OFFENDERS MUST ACCOMPANY ALL PROTESTS. FAILURE OF ANY CONTESTANT TO BE CLEARED BY THE POLYGRAPH RESULTS AND THOSE THAT DO NOT AGREE TO BE TESTED BY POLYGRAPH MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION, LOSS OF ENTRY FEE AND ANY PRIZES.

**14. OFFICIAL CHECKPOINT:** THERE SHALL BE ONLY ONE OFFICIAL CHECK POINT FOR CHECK-IN IN THE AFTERNOON. THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL DESIGNATE THIS POINT. PARTNERS MUST REMAIN TOGETHER UNTIL THEIR FISH ARE WEIGHED.

**15. SCORING:** TOURNAMENT STANDINGS, AUXILIARY AWARDS AND FINAL WINNERS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMPETITOR'S CATCH DURING THE COMPETITION DAYS. ONLY LARGEMOUTH, SMALLMOUTH, SPOTTED, REDEYE OR SHOAL BASS WILL BE WEIGHED. THE LIMIT SHALL BE 5 FISH PER TEAM PER DAY. AT NO TIME SHALL A COMPETITOR HAVE POSSESSION OF MORE THAN THE TOURNAMENT LIMIT. ONLY BASS MEASURING 14" OR MORE WHEN MEASURED ON A STRAIGHT LINE WILL COUNT AS A LEGAL CATCH EXCEPT AT LAKES WHERE THE LENGTH LIMIT VARIES (I.E. 16-INCH, 18-INCH, ETC.) BASS PRESENTED AT WEIGH-IN WHICH FALL SHORT OF THE MINIMUM LENGTH SHALL DISQUALIFY THAT DAY'S CATCH. ANY BASS THAT APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN MANGLED, MASHED OR OTHERWISE ALTERED WILL BE WEIGHED AND CREDITED ONLY AT THE TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL'S DISCRETION. ONCE A TEAM'S FISH HAS BEEN MEASURED AND COUNTED AND VERIFIED BY AN OFFICIAL THAT TEAM MAY NOT RETURN TO HIS BOAT UNTIL AFTER HIS CATCH HAS BEEN WEIGHED, RECORDED AND THEIR WEIGH-IN SLIP SIGNED. BASS MUST NOT BE PLACED ON A STRINGER AT ANY TIME DURING THE TOURNAMENT.

**16. KILLING YOUR CATCH:** EACH COMPETITOR IS EXPECTED TO KEEP HIS CATCH ALIVE AND PROPERLY AERATED. THERE WILL BE A .25LB PENALTY FOR EACH DEAD FISH PRESENTED AT THE WEIGH IN.

**17. LATE PENALTY:** COMPETITORS WHO ARE NOT IN THE OFFICIAL CHECKPOINT AREA AT THE APPOINTED TIME SHALL BE PENALIZED AT THE RATE OF 1 POUND PER MINUTE, TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE TOTAL WEIGHT OF HIS CATCH THAT DAY. THIS WILL INCLUDE BIG BASS WEIGHT. ANY COMPETITOR MORE THAN 15 MINUTE LATE SHALL LOSE ALL CREDIT FOR THAT DAY'S CATCH. ALL FISHING MUST CEASE WHEN THAT CONTESTANT HAS CHECKED IN. AFTER THE TOURNAMENT BEGINS, FISHING ON TOURNAMENT WATER IS PROHIBITED EXCEPT DURING THE TOURNAMENT HOURS. EXACT STARTING AND CHECK-IN TIMES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE TOURNAMENT BRIEFING.

**18. TIES:** CONTESTANTS THAT TIE FOR A PLACE WILL SPLIT THE PRIZES OF THAT AND THE NEXT LOWER PLACE.

**19. BIG BASS POT:** IF OVER 50 TEAMS PARTICIPATE IN THE TOURNAMENT, OFFICIALS WILL PAY TWO (2) PLACES FOR BIG BASS WITH A 60/40 SPLIT OF THE BIG BASS POT.

**20. PRIZE MONEY:** BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM EACH CONTESTANT REPRESENTS THAT HE OR SHE UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THE PRIZE MONEY TO BE PAID MAY BE ADJUSTED BASED ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ENTRIES. PAYOUT WILL BASE ON ONE (1) PLACE FOR EVERY SEVEN (7) TEAMS ENTERED IN THE TOURNAMENT.

**21. ANGLERS OF THE YEAR:** WILL RECEIVE FREE ENTRY TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP AND ALL EVENTS FOR THE NEXT SEASON, PLUS CUSTOM PLAQUES. (MUST PAY CHAMPIONSHIP FEE AND ALL REGISTRATION FEES FOR THE NEXT YEAR)
